Itinerary:

Day 2

Buenos Aires. Arrival and transfer to the hotel. In the afternoon city tour: The city of Buenos Aires, one of most important of Latin America, is a great cosmopolitan and multifunctional metropolis. With evident universal influence, it causes astonishment in tourists. Its European architecture resembles the streets of Paris and that's why it is known as "the Paris of America". Witnesses of their most important cultural life are their numerous museums, exhibition and conference halls, art galleries, cinemas and theaters with national and international first class shows of. The Colon theatre, one of the most important lyric theaters of the world, is host, among other varied scenes, of an intense musical activity and it is visited frequently by orchestras, groups and soloists from around the world. The typical and famous Tango shines in different neighborhoods as La Boca, El Abasto and San Telmo. Financial, stock-exchange and economic seat of the country, is the main port of the nation. Its commercial activity is very intense, which is reflected in the numerous shops of the most important brands of the world, commercial galleries and shopping malls.

Day 3

Buenos Aires. Breakfast. In the morning Delta del Tigre Tour: We will visit the northern area of Buenos Aires. As we pass through the parks and the beautiful buildings, we can see a sensational panoramic view of la Plata River, the widest river in the world.

We will see Jorge Newbery Airport, River Plate Stadium, University of Buenos Aires, Olivos residence (where the president lives). Then we will arrive to Tigre where we will begin our navigation into the Parana Delta. Hundreds of island are part of this unique ecosystem that it is located only 20km distance from Buenos Aires. We will return to the city in the coast train that connects the most elegant residential areas facing the River. The last part of the tour will be done by bus.

Day 4

Buenos Aires. Breakfast. Day at leisure. We suggest Gaucho Party tour: In this tour we will find the gaucho's county side life and the peaceful and kind town where he lives. That is why the Argentine Pampa is part of our tradition. The asado (barbecue), gaucho's activities and abilities, dances, and folk games are some of the options to enjoy. Pampa is like this, gauchos, fields, traditions, crafts, a tour to learn and enjoy. This fullday tour includes lunch.

Day 5

Buenos Aires - Puerto Iguazu. Breakfast. Transfer to the airport. Flight to Iguazu. Arrival and transfer

to the hotel. In the afternoon Brazilian falls tour: Once inside the park, visitors will be astonished by its neatness, beauty and extension (175.000 has). Also the same as in the National Park of Argentina, you will find a great bio-diversity. For sure nature will welcome them with fantastic colorful butterfly's, which are a delight to watch as they fly in hundreds, offering a great natural show. Due to the fact that 80% of the falls belong to Argentina, the Brazilian park has to offer only one walking trail, of about 1000m of length. From this trail you will have the best panoramic views, of all of the falls from both countries. Located at the end of this trail, there is an elevator, which offers a wonderful view of the Brazilian park, and the "Floreano" fall. For sure one of the most beautiful views in this park.

Day 6

Puerto Iguazu. Breakfast. In the morning Argentinean falls tour: Located inside the Iguazú National Park you will find more than 200 waterfalls, from 30 to 80mts high, which all together are called to be the "Iguazú Falls". The Argentine side of the falls is divided into 3 trails (Upper, inferior and Devils Throat).

This tour take you to visit part of the Iguazú National Park. It preserves 67.000 ha. of giant trees, vines and ferns living with multicolored butterflies, birds and other mammals all of them part of the rich local flora and fauna. The park was declared Natural World Heritage in 1984, due to its scenic beauties and the great biological diversity of the subtropical jungle. The famous falls are in the heart of this Park. We start the visit at the Local Museum and continue the tour with the Lower Trail, from where we can see among others, the " Two sisters Falls", the "Bossetti Fall", the "Hidden Fall", a panoramic view of "San Martin island " and the "Union Fall". Later we walk the Upper Trail shifting along walkways located above major falls up to the majestic "San Martin Fall" from where we have a panoramic view of the Brazilian falls. Finally, we go with the Train of the Jungle up to "Devil's Throat" station. From there, after 1,000 meters walk along the catwalks, we come to the spectacular "Devil's Throat", where the Iguazu river speaks with all its strength and the falling water gives the illusion of magic rainbows.

Day 7

Puerto Iguazu - Rio de Janeiro. Breakfast. Transfer to the airport. Flight to Rio de Janeiro. Arrival and transfer to the hotel.

Day 8

Rio de Janeiro. Breakfast. In the morning City tour and Sugar loaf : Downtown is the business heart of Rio. It is a part of the city where colonial Rio meets modern skyscrapers. Passing through Rio Branco Avenue, you will see the Candelaria Church, which was started being built in the late 18th century and was completed in 1898. The headquarter of major Brazilian banks and commercial enterprises is located on this avenue. You will also see the Opera House (Teatro Municipal) and the Carioca Square, the church of Santo Antonio built in the 17th century as well as the contrast of the modern buildings such as Petrobras and the Cathedral. Moreover you will get to know Rio's aqueduct built in the 18th century which is nowadays connecting downtown to Santa Teresa district, an old residential area. Afterwards you will drive through one of the highlights of this tour: the Flamengo Park from where you have the chance to see already the top highlight of this tour, the Sugar Loaf. This famous mountain reached by a cable car 1,200 feet high, will give you an experience you will never forget: looking down at Rio from top of the Sugar Loaf is one of the most spectacular views in the world.

Day 9

Rio de Janeiro. Breakfast. Transfer to Buzios.
