Itinerary:

Day 1

Buenos Aires. Arrival and transfer to the hotel.

Day 2

Buenos Aires. In the morning city tour: The city of Buenos Aires, one of most important of Latin America, is a great cosmopolitan and multifunctional metropolis. With evident universal influence, it causes astonishment in tourists. Its European architecture resembles the streets of Paris and that's why it is known as "the Paris of America". Witnesses of their most important cultural life are their numerous museums, exhibition and conference halls, art galleries, cinemas and theaters with national and international first class shows of. The Colon theatre, one of the most important lyric theaters of the world, is host, among other varied scenes, of an intense musical activity and it is visited frequently by orchestras, groups and soloists from around the world. The typical and famous Tango shines in different neighborhoods as La Boca, El Abasto and San Telmo. Financial, stock-exchange and economic seat of the country, is the main port of the nation. Its commercial activity is very intense, which is reflected in the numerous shops of the most important brands of the world, commercial galleries and shopping malls.

Day 3

Buenos Aires. Day at leisure. We suggest Gaucho Party tour: In this tour we will find the gaucho's county side life and the peaceful and kind town where he lives. That is why the Argentine Pampa is part of our tradition. The asado (barbecue), gaucho's activities and abilities, dances, and folk games are some of the options to enjoy. Pampa is like this, gauchos, fields, traditions, crafts, a tour to learn and enjoy. This full day tour includes lunch.

Day 4

Buenos Aires - Puerto Iguazu. Breakfast. Flight to Puerto Iguazú. Arrival and transfer to the hotel.

Day 5

Puerto Iguazu. Breakfast. In the morning Argentinean falls: Located inside the Iguazú National Park you will find more than 200 waterfalls, from 30 to 80mts high, which all together are called to be the "Iguazú Falls". The Argentine side of the falls is divided into 3 trails (Upper, inferior and Devils Throat). This tour take you to visit part of the Iguazú National Park. It preserves 67.000 ha. of giant trees, vines and ferns living with multicolored butterflies, birds and other mammals all of them part of the rich local flora and fauna. We start the visit at the Local Museum and continue the tour with the Lower Trail, from where we can see among others, the "Two sisters Falls", the "Bossetti Fall", the "Hidden Fall", a panoramic view of "San Martin island" and the "Union Fall". Later we walk the

Upper Trail shifting along walkways located above major falls up to the majestic "San Martin Fall" from where we have a panoramic view of the Brazilian falls. Finally, we go with the Train of the Jungle up to "Devil's Throat" station. From there, after 1,000 meters walk along the catwalks, we come to the spectacular "Devil's Throat", where the Iguazu river speaks with all its strength and the falling water gives the illusion of magic rainbows.

Day 6

Puerto Iguazu. Breakfast. Day at leisure. We suggest Brazilian falls: Once inside the park, visitors will be astonished by its neatness, beauty and extension (175.000 has). Also the same as in the National Park of Argentina, you will find a great bio-diversity. For sure nature will welcome them with fantastic colorful butterfly's, which are a delight to watch as they fly in hundreds, offering a great natural show.

Due to the fact that 80% of the falls belong to Argentina, the Brazilian park has to offer only one walking trail, of about 1000m of length. From this trail you will have the best panoramic views, of all of the falls from both countries. Located at the end of this trail, there is an elevator, which offers a wonderful view of the Brazilian park, and the "Floreano" fall. For sure one of the most beautiful views in this park.

Day 7

Puerto Iguazu - El Calafate. Breakfast. Transfer to the airport. Flight to El Calafate. Arrival and transfer to the hotel.

Day 8

El Calafate. Breakfast. In the morning Perito Moreno Glacier Tour: We will drive 80km next to Argentino Lake until we reach Los Glaciares National park. It is incredible how different it is the vegetation next to Andes. We will drive following Brazo Rico (arm of Argentino Lake) till we arrive to the whisper turn, there we will find the amazing Perito Moreno Glacier. We will park in the footbridge area where we will admire the Perito Moreno Glacier and witness the fall of ice blocks from a close distance.

Every viewpoint offers a new perspective. From the entrance of the footbridge area, there is a distance of 400 meters to the lowest balcony, the closest to the front of the glacier. The intermediate balcony is the best place to appreciate the northern area of the glacier with a good sight of the Canal de los Témpanos and towards the left of this viewpoint is the second balcony, right opposite the glacier. Even if the largest glaciers in the Park are the Viedma and the Upsala, the Perito Moreno is a large sized glacier located only 200 meters over sea level, which enables to reach its very front easily, not like the other glaciers, which can only be accessed after trekking or sailing for a while.

Day 9

El Calafate. Breakfast. Day at leisure. We suggest Express Ice Navigation: The schedule of shipment in the port of Punta Bandera Private (47 kilometers from the city of El Calafate), will be at 08:30 am and the game will be at 09:00 am, after the passengers are informed the safety and seaworthiness. Once on board sail across the North Arm of Lake Argentino to reach the Channel Upsala, where we will find a spectacular Barrier Icebergs. From there we will have a panoramic view of the Upsala Glacier. Then navigate Spegazzini Channel, where we observe the Seco Glacier to reach the front of Spegazzini Glacier, the highest in the National Park. Return to Private Puerto Punta Bandera will be at approximately 04:00 pm, by boat. The tour can be modified depending on weather conditions and safety and the decision of the captain of the boat.

Day 10

El Calafate - Buenos Aires - Scandinavia. Breakfast. Transfer to the airport. Flight to Buenos Aires. Arrival and transfer to the international airport for flight to Scandinavia.
